# Requirements:

Master degree in Social Sciences;

- fluency in qualitative social research methods; basic skills in quantitative methods in social research are an asset;
- familiarity with complexity science/systems theory and approach, including specific tools enabling data mining;
- experience with designing and leading stakeholder dialogue and engagement on socioenvironmental issues, including interviews, workshops, seminars, etc.;
- experience in leadership and/or independent roles in complex, international projects are huge assets;
- knowledge and skills in environmental management experience in working with wetlands habitats and species especially desirable (demonstrated socio-environmental interdisciplinarity);
- experience in policy analysis;
- strong motivation to scientific work as well as creativity in problem-solving, selfreliance;
- proved ability to work in a scientific, ideally international, team;
- fluency (speech, writing, reading on scientific level) in Polish and English.

  Communicative French and/or German and/or Latvian is an additional advantage;
- high-degree availability for independent, frequent traveling across project sites in France, Germany and Latvia;
  - ability to work in/with different sectors (NGOs, academia, public administration, business, citizens, land owners, land managers) on different levels (EU, national, regional, local);
- public communication and educational skills, especially in topics related to environment/sustainability/biodiversity;
- interest and ideally experience in interdisciplinary approaches;
- demonstrated ability to write and/or critically assess grey literature (analyses, etc.)/scientific publications/proposals and project reporting documents;

#### Description of tasks:

The successful PhD candidate will be involved in the socio-ecological assessment of wetland restoration and turtle reintroduction. The candidate will do research at the French, German and Latvian field sites, which have different socio-ecological settings, and will also be

assisting trainings and meetings in Poland. More specifically, the successful candidate will conduct the following tasks:

- social, economical and socio-environmental data collection, analysis and synthesis;
- supporting (ideally leading) interviews with stakeholders, field sessions, public perception seminars and workshops in project countries aiming at assessing how restoration of wetlands and reintroduction of an endangered species may contribute to new and deeper links between people and nature;
- literature review on social benefits of restoration and conservation, place and nature attachments, social-ecological systems, dynamics and potency for transformative change in biodiversity governance both grey and scientific, in English, as well as, ideally, other European languages;
- writing scientific publications, contributing to national and international conferences, as well as to internal reports and international guidelines which are part of the deliverables of the project;
- working in interdisciplinary settings with project partners on relevant project's tasks.
