The University has established in 2015, a Special Purpose Entity responsible for research commercialization – Medical Innovation Centre Ltd. Since now three spin-off companies have been created. Technology Transfer Office has also experience in commercialisation and validation of innovations gained during the implementation of the grant from Ministry of National Education of the Republic of Poland Innovation Incubator+ "Support for scientific research management and commercialization of R&D work results in scientific units and enterprises".

Nowadays the MUG is the first institution in Pomerania coordinating the Regional Innovation Scheme (RIS) as part of the EIT Health programme supporting innovation in healthy living and active ageing. The TTO team as a part of EIT Health programme focuses on helping MUG's scientists to find and cooperate with relevant business partners to create innovative enterprises providing maximum value to the local economy ecosystem.
